1. Context:

International Women's Day is commemorated on March 8th. In observance of this occasion, LSE's Gender Equity community, Colombian and Latin American Societies have jointly organized a forum to explore perspectives on wellbeing. Though women have different experiences, we all share common ground in encountering and overcoming challenges that have transformed our realities.

We believe that wellbeing serves as a broad and inclusive "umbrella" concept, allowing for an exchange of diverse experiences that reflect our individual perspectives, purposes, and desires. Moreover, adopting an intersectional perspective on wellbeing is an important contribution to formulating and designing new public policies that aim to achieve women's equality, and serves as a source of inspiration.

2. Objective:

The objective of this forum is to foster a platform for women with diverse backgrounds and areas of expertise to share their experiences under the overarching "umbrella" topic of wellbeing.

We aim to discover to what extent our guests have encountered obstacles in achieving wellbeing while navigating their careers, and whether they anticipate





future challenges in this regard (past and future perspectives on wellbeing). We also seek to understand what the concept of wellbeing means to each guest in their respective areas of expertise.

It is worth noting that the wellbeing category was chosen as it enables us to gather diverse perspectives and promotes greater intersectionality, reconciling polarized positions from different ideological currents and/or imaginations.
